GUIDELINES

1. Project's Aim

“Congresso Studentesco MoReMED” main goal is to offer medical fields students the opportunity to become peers and not purely observator of researches. The congress wants to go beyond what's normally offered and expand students' curricula.

The purpose is to endorse the pursue of knowledge though research, co-working, practical activities, and transposal of reliable scientific informations.

1.1 Organization of the IX Edition

IX Edition of the Student Congress MoReMED will be held in Modena.

2. Active Participants – Students EXHIBITORS

These expressions “Active Participants” and “Students Exhibitors” re referred to students who desire to apply to the possibility of presenting their work. There are available 26 total slots.

Based on the actual University's protocol, the Organizing Committee is allowed to adapt the congress to an online format. In this case slots would reduce to 10.

2.1 Who can apply?

- Duly enrolled students in their 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th year of Medicine and Surgery degree course
- Duly enrolled students in their 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th year of a Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics degree course
- Duly enrolled students in their 3rd and students who graduated up to six months prior to the event from any of the three-year-health-related degree course
- Duly enrolled students in their 3rd,4th,5th of a Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Technology degree course
- Duly enrolled students on a Biology Master's degree course:
 - Applied Health and Nutrition
 - Biomedical applications
 - Applied biomedical research
 - Cellular and molecular
 - Health
 - Experimental and applied
 - Biomethodologies
 - Medical and pharmaceutical biotechnology
 - Biotechnology applied to biomedical research
 - Genetics
 - Functional genomics
 - Neurobiology
 - Neuropsychobiology
 - Neuroscience
- Biological sciences



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- Applied Biological sciences
- Biological and Health sciences
- Applied Biomolecular Science
- Biomolecular and cellular sciences
- Biological Monitoring Sciences and Technologies
- Students recently graduated from Medicine and Surgery during the academic year 2022-2023.

Application from students not from Italian university are accepted.

2.2 How can you apply?

You can apply individually or in a group of maximum 3 students. It's not possible to take part of different groups and it's not possible that one group presents different researches.

Applications that don't meet these requirements are therefore excluded.

2.3 Which type of works are accepted?

In order to follow the purpose of the project the students of Medicine and Surgery have to explore subjects outside the university career or to examine avantgarde subjects.

Students of Dentistry, undergraduate health-related degree programs, Biology, Biotechnologies, Pharmacology and pharmaceutical biotechnology and chemistry have to expose subject of the medical fields.

2.4 What can you apply?

It's possible the presentation of two different types of works:

- Original Article
- Review Article

Original Article is an article recently published or not yet published and the presentation includes the results of the study (where the students took actively part).

Review Article is a analysis of the scientific literature on a specific topic.

Each type of work will have the registration, evaluation, classification and number of spots dedicated. During the registration, the student has to submit every detail on the website www.moremed.unimore.it. The Selection Committee will will notify if there is a mismatch.

2.5 How does the application works?

During the registration it will be necessary to submit the Total Number of members, the MD or supervisor professor of the work, and the abstract itself.

The maximum length is 3000 words including spaces, and the bibliography about the most relevant sources must be added (max three). The bibliography isn't included in the count of the characters.

Only abstracts written in Italian or English are accepted.

2.6 Selection Process:



The abstracts will be evaluated by a "Selection Committee" consisting of professors from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia and affiliated with the Scientific Secretariat of the Congress. During the selection of the presented works, the following criteria will be considered:

- The scientific approach.
- The expansion of the educational offering.
- The alignment with the project's goals (see sections 1 and 2.3).

Among the "Original Articles," preference will be given to works in advanced stages of development at the time of application and that provide convincing data in support of their hypotheses. Additionally, during the selection process, priority will be given to works by students compared to those by recent graduates in Medicine and Surgery.

Only the following information will be transmitted to the Selection Committee: title, abstract, article type, university, and degree program. To ensure an entirely impartial evaluation, the names of candidates and tutors will not be shown.

In case authors do not confirm their participation, the subsequent works will be selected based on the ranking. The selected abstracts will be published on the Congress website with the names of the authors and their tutors.

2.7 Selection Outcome:

The Congress provides a total of 26 exhibition slots dedicated to Active Participants, divided as follows:

- 16 in the Plenary Session.
- 10 in the Poster Session.

The top 16 works will be presented by the authors in the Plenary Session, while the next 10 will be presented as Posters in a designated exhibition area and during a separate session. In case the Congress is held in a virtual format, the number of available slots for the Plenary Session will be reduced to 10. Therefore, during the work selection process, the top 10 presented abstracts will be identified, with a greater emphasis on "Original Articles."

2.8 Deadlines:

Registrations for Active Participants will open on Monday, **November 6, 2023**, at 12:00 AM and close on Monday, **January 29, 2024**, at 11:59 PM. Communication of the rankings will take place by no later than Monday, March 11, 2024.

Students and groups selected for the Plenary Session must send the final PowerPoint file of their presentation to the email address moremed@unimore.it. Students and groups selected for the Poster Session must send the final Poster (in .pdf or .jpg format) to the same email address moremed@unimore.it.



All the upmentioned material must be sent no later than Monday, **March 25, 2024**.

Students selected for the Poster Session are responsible for printing their work in physical copy. It must be submitted to the Organizing Committee on the same day of the presentation at the Congress.

2.9 Exhibition:

The presentation of students in the Plenary Session will take place on Thursday, April 11, and Friday, April 12, 2024, at the Educational Center of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery UNIMORE. Each student or student group will have a maximum of 12 minutes for the presentation of their work, followed by a maximum of 3 minutes Q&A session. Adherence to the provided time limits is mandatory, with interruptions in case of non-compliance.

The Poster Session will be held in person at the Educational Services Center of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery UNIMORE. **In case a student is under certified quarantine by their attending physician, a remote connection will be guaranteed.**

The event will be broadcast live on tv.unimore.it and on the social platforms of the MoReMED Student Congress, and PowerPoint presentations and Posters will be subsequently published on the Congress website.

2.10 Language:

The Abstract, PowerPoint presentations, Posters, and oral presentations can be conducted in either Italian or English language.

2.11 Awards:

In the Plenary Session, there will be dedicated Evaluation Committees that will assess the works based on various parameters, including presentation general form and accuracy of datas, communicative effectiveness, presentation rigor, and PowerPoint quality.

The awards ceremony will take place at the end of the second day of the Congress and will be divided by work type: the best works from the Plenary Session and the Poster Session will be awarded.

2.12 Credits

For students in Medicine and Surgery at UNIMORE, 1 ADE Credit is granted in case of passing the selection and presenting the work. For students from other degree programs at UNIMORE or from other universities, it is subject to individual arrangements with the respective Program Directors.



3. Other Participants - Spectator Students

"Spectator Students" refer to students who intend to participate in the Congress solely as spectators of the event.

3.1 Who Can Participate?

The "MoReMED Student Congress" is open to anyone who wishes to take part, following registration in the appropriate section of the official website. However, it is primarily aimed at students enrolled in degree programs in Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics, Health Sciences, PA, Biological Sciences, Biotechnology, Pharmacy, and CTF.

3.2 How to Register?

Registrations will open on **Monday, March 11, 2024**, and will be exclusively done online via a dedicated form on the official website.

3.3 Registration Costs

Participating in the "MoReMED Student Congress" is completely free of charge.

3.4 Credits

The number of credits assigned for each congress day is 0.25 ADE credits for students of UNIMORE enrolled before the 2020/2021 academic year, and 0.2 ADE credits for students of UNIMORE enrolled from the 2020/2021 academic year. For students from other degree programs at UNIMORE or from other universities, it is subject to individual arrangements with the respective Program Directors.


