

Abstract for the MoReMED Congress: how to write it?

If you are applying with an Original Article:

- **Introduction - Background:** define the scope in which your article is located and make a brief presentation of the state of the art. It is necessary to introduce the search question, highlighting how your article can implement current knowledge in the field of interest. Finally, define the purpose of the article;
- **Methods:** outline the procedures followed and the materials used to collect information, emphasising the strengths and weaknesses of your approach;
- **Results:** expose the data collected in numerical and statistical terms;
- **Discussion - Conclusion:** make a brief comment on the results obtained in relation to what was already known in the literature, focussing on the strengths and weaknesses of the research. Finally, indicate whether your hypothesis found the support of the facts and what emerged in general from your study.
- Any other sections may be entered at the discretion of the candidates.

If you are applying with a Review Article:

- **Introduction - Background:** define the scope in which your article is located and make a brief presentation of the state of the art. Finally, define the purpose of the article;
- **Methods:** outline an overview of the items taken into consideration, explaining the reason why you selected them, the methodology followed and the criteria according to which the selection was made;
- **Results:** expose the data that emerged from your work in numerical and statistical terms;
- **Discussion - Conclusion:** make a brief comment on the results, focussing on the strengths and weaknesses of the work and indicating what emerged in general from your study.
- Any other sections may be entered at the discretion of the candidates.

As required by the regulation, the paper must be written in **Italian** or **English** and contain a maximum of **3000 characters**, including spaces. An essential bibliography should be added, which must include the 3 most significant articles examined. The bibliography is not included in the number of characters.
