

Poster for MoReMED Congress: how to proceed

Software: Use Microsoft PowerPoint to create your poster. To ensure the size, follow these steps:

- File
- Slide Size

Then change the **Width** and **Height** parameters with the values of **841mm** and **1189mm** Respectively (dimension A0) and set the **vertical orientation**.

Text: use the Arial font for the text. The recommended dimensions to ensure easy reading are as follows:

- Title: 85 pts
- Authors: 56 pt
- Subtitles: 36 pts
- Text body: 24 pt
- Image captions: 18 pt

Use **Bold** for **keywords**.

The text can be written in both **Italian** and **English**.

Layout and Content: the posters will be read from left to right. Make sure that the layout is easy to follow and that the concepts are clearly expressed for those who will read them. At the top of the poster position:

- Title of the paper
- Names of the authors
- Logo of the university of origin
- MoReMED logo

Divide the poster into several **paragraphs** marked with **subtitles**, which can be:

- **Background or State of the art**
- **Methods and Materials**
- **Results**
- **Discussion**
- **Bibliography**
- Impact of research
- Limitations
- Acknowledgements
- Conclusions

Note: Only those marked in bold are mandatory.

Tables and Figures: it is recommended to use original tables and figures. If necessary, it is still possible to use high-definition images from pre-existing publications by citing the article in the bibliography.

The titles of the Tables should be placed above them, while those of the Figures should be placed below.

Tables and Images will attract more attention from readers and are therefore strongly recommended!
